TREE STAND REMOVAL

1. Hunters using the County of Middlesex owned woodlands are strictly prohibited from erecting permanent tree stands/structures that are attached to trees using any hardware that may injure damage or, impede the growth of the tree.
2. Tree stands used during the hunting season in County owned Woodlots must be removed on or before the end of the hunting season.
3. The owner of this tree stand is required to post their name and contact details clearly on the tree stand.
4. The County reserves the right to remove any tree stand if the owner has not removed it before the last day of the hunting season.
5. The owner must ensure that they install tree stands responsibly and adjust all straps securing the tree stand so as not to cause damage to the tree.
6. Hunters use of a tree stand, do so entirely at their own risk.
