TREE STAND REMOVAL

- 1. Hunters using the County of Middlesex owned woodlands are strictly prohibited from erecting permanent tree stands/structures that are attached to trees using any hardware that may injure damage or, impede the growth of the tree.
- 2. Tree stands used during the hunting season in County owned Woodlots must be removed on or before the end of the hunting season.
- 3. The owner of this tree stand is required to post their name and contact details clearly on the tree stand.
- 4. The County reserves the right to remove any tree stand if the owner has not removed it before the last day of the hunting season.
- 5. The owner must ensure that they install tree stands responsibly and adjust all straps securing the tree stand so as not to cause damage to the tree.
- 6. Hunters use of a tree stand, do so entirely at their own risk.
