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Woodland Clearing Permit Requirements / Information

- A Council Exemption (Woodland Clearing Permit) application must be completed in full to be processed. An application for an area greater than one (1) hectare (2.5 acres) must be accompanied by an Environmental Impact Study.
- II. When an Owner or authorized agent inquires about the Woodlands By-law, it shall be standard practice for the Officer to inspect the property to determine whether an application for a Council Exemption is necessary. Notice of this permit application shall be sent by regular mail to all landowners whose lands about the land outlined in the application. Landowners separated by a public road allowance shall also be considered abutting landowners. The application may also be circulated to relevant government agencies for review and comments (i.e., Conservation Authorities, Ministry of Natural Resources, Ministry of Agriculture & Food, and local Municipalities).
- Any person applying for a Council Exemption Permit shall erect and display a public notice regarding the Council Exemption application at the entrance from the adjoining roadway to the land where the Council Exemption Permit is being sought. This notice must be placed in a position that is clear and visible to all persons, and follow the format provided in Schedule "H".
- M. The hearing for the application shall not be scheduled less than twenty-one (21) Business Days from receipt of the completed application.
- V. If the application is approved, an on-site inspection will be conducted, and the perimeter of the forest cover that will remain will be marked with paint or another clear indicator to denote the extent of the approved Permit area. Any trees destroyed outside the approved area will be considered a violation under the Woodland By-law.

- **Note 1:** If signed by an agent, written authorization from the owner must accompany the application. If the applicant is a corporation, the application shall be signed by an officer of the corporation and the corporation's seal shall be affixed.
- Note 2: Each application must be accompanied by a map showing the parcel of land that is the subject of the application, including the boundaries and dimensions of the total holdings. The map must also indicate the size and area of the trees to be removed, portions of the woodland to be retained, and the location of the property in relation to abutting properties, specifying their land use (e.g., residential, agricultural, cottage, commercial, etc.)
