Overview of the Position

As a member of the nursing team and under the supervision of the direct Registered Nurse, the Registered Practical Nurse (RPN) is involved in the planning, implementation and evaluation of resident care in accordance with the current Standards of Nursing Practice specified by the College of Nurses of Ontario (CNO,) the policies and procedures of Strathmere Lodge, and the Long-Term Care Homes Act (LTCHA, 2007.). This is a temporary, relief/on-call position. Relief/on-call shifts may vary from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., 3:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. and/or 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. **The successful candidate must be available to work weekdays, weekends and statutory holidays, and must be available on short notice for call in shifts.**

Vaccine Verification

As a condition of employment, the successful candidate will be required to provide proof of full vaccination or provide proof of valid exemption satisfactory to the Home prior to the start date. The successful candidate acknowledges and agrees to comply with any future vaccine policy requirements as an ongoing condition of employment at Strathmere Lodge.
